

APPLICATION POINT SYSTEM

Qualifying applications will be reviewed and scored according to the following point system. Points will not be given unless the applicant provides written documentation (letters from employers on company letterhead, DD214, course certificates, school transcripts, etc.).

1 Valid Driver’s License (2% of overall score)	2
2 High School Education (Required) (3 % of overall score)	3
High School Diploma	2 points
GPA greater than or equal to 2.0	1 point
GED	1 point
GED total score greater than or equal to 255 (or 2550 for GEDs obtained after 1/1/02)	1 point
3 Math Classes with passing grades (“C”) (5% of overall score)	5
High School Algebra (required) per semester creditor equivalent	1 point
Advanced math (trigonometry, geometry, calculus) with a minimum grade of “C” per semester credit or equivalent	2 points
4 Work Experience (10% of overall score)	10
General: 4,000 hours	1 point
Occupation related: 1,000 hours	4 points
5 Military Experience, Americorp, Peace Corps (10% of overall score)	10
General: 1 year	1 point
Protective Signaling; 1,000 hours	4 points
Limited Energy: 1,000 hours	3 points
Building Construction: 1,000 hours	2 points
6 Education related to Occupation with a minimum grade of “C” (10% of overall score)	10
(AC/DC electricity, fundamental electronics, electrical wiring, blueprint reading, etc.) per semester credit or equivalent	2 points
7 Graduate of an approved pre-apprenticeship program equivalent in time and content to a one (1) year (2,000 hours) program. (10% of overall score) Programs of lesser time and content will be scored at 1 point per every 200 hours.	10
8 Interview (50% of overall score)	50
Attitude	18 points
Interest	16 points
Maturity	16 points
