To All Training Agents and Apprentices:

On April 16, 2014 the Protective Signaling JATC took action to accept and notify the Bureau of Labor and Industries, Apprenticeship and Training Division of its annual wage determination. The average journeyman wage accepted by the committee is **\$25.38** for Class "A" Limited Energy journey persons. These wages will be effective **May 1, 2014**.

The **wage progression** is as follows:
